Re: Nets

Prior to 2011, only STX and Warrior were approved to manufacture 4x4'6 nets and the application of a 'CLA Approved' sticker on approved nets was not yet a requirement of approved net manufacturers. Therefore, 4x4'6 nets manufactured by Warrior and STX should be allowed in game play even if they do not have a CLA Approved sticker on them.

Nets can be anchored by pegs. If nets are being pegged, a peg should go up inside the net, come across the goal line no more than 3 inches and then go into the floor. The height of the peg across the goal line shall not be more than 1/16 inch and therefore shouldn't interfere with balls entering the net.
